

1968 DeTour Raiders Football Team Posted a 7-0-1 Overall Record

 Martin Ledy completed 10 of 13 passes for 296 yards and four touchdowns to lift the Raiders to a 46-13 league win over archrival Pickford Panthers.

Tim Tischer caught two of Ledy's aerials for touchdowns, while Rich Bailey returned a kickoff 88 yards and one pass reception for scores; Lewis Woods had one scoring pass, and Chuck Moser rushed for the final touchdown. Defensive stats: Red Adams 10; Wayne Bailey, Rich Bailey, Tom Soczek, John Cochran, and Ed Bailey 4.

The Martin Ledy-to-Rich Bailey combination accounted for four touchdowns as DeTour blanked the Brimley Bays 38-0. Tim Tischer and Chuck Moser scored the final two touchdowns as the Raiders improved their record to 4-0-1. Defensive stats: Ed Bailey 11, Rich Bailey 8, Lewis Woods 6.

DeTour edged the Rudyard Bulldogs 26-20 in the Raiders' homecoming contest as Chuck Moser rushed for two touchdowns, Martin Ledy scored from five yards out, and Ledy-to-Rich Bailey combined on the winning score late in the game. Defensive stats: Red Adams 13; Rich Bailey 10; Chuck Moser 8; Paul Potwardski and Larry Ledy 6.

The offense scored three touchdowns and the defense added two scores in the Raiders 38-6 win over the Inland Lakes Bulldogs. Tim Tischer and Lewis Woods scored on passes from Martin Ledy, Chuck Moser and Ledy scored rushing touchdowns, and Ed Bailey and Ledy returned pass interceptions for scores. Defensive stats: Tim Tischer 15; Ed Bailey 14; Red Adams 12; Rich Bailey 11; Gerald VanAlstine 8.

Sault Loretto Angels stood between DeTour and their undefeated season, and the Raiders took control early for a 38-6 victory.

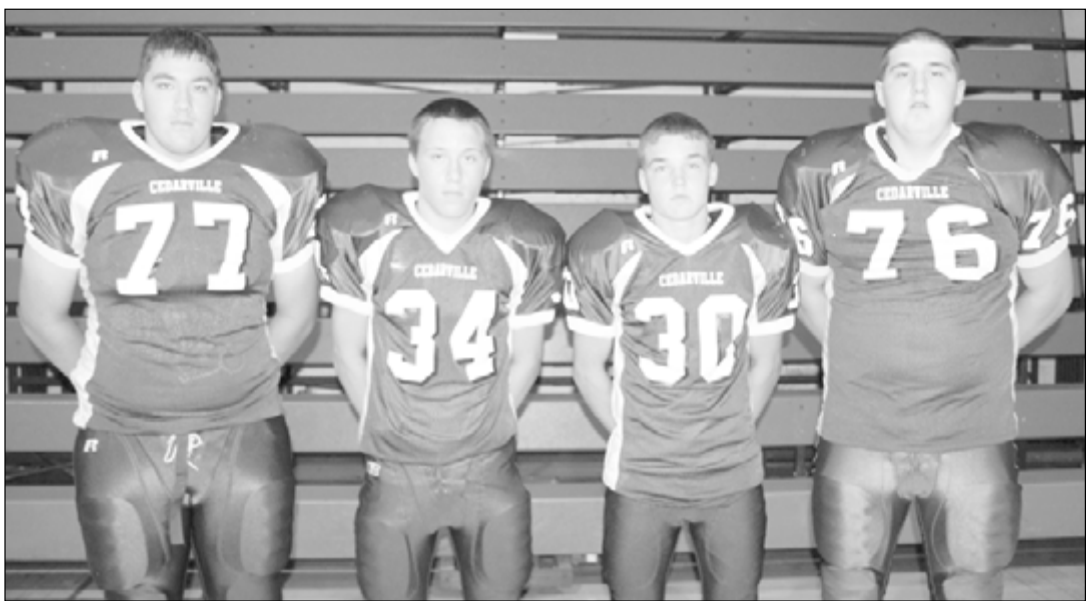

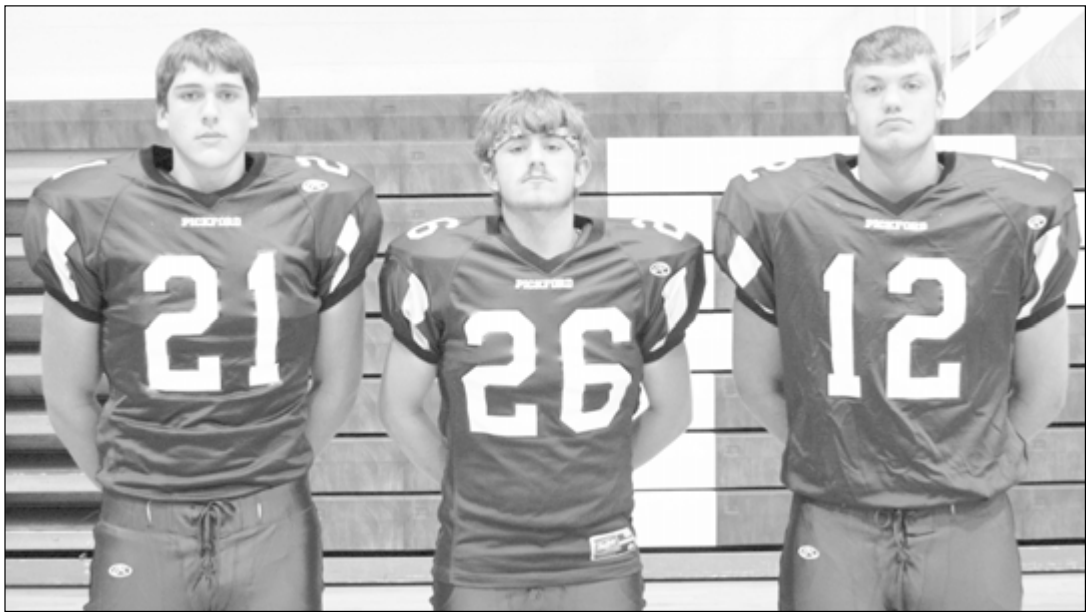
