Mr. Engle, with family and friends, made the trip to Brooklyn to watch the Nextel Race and to be part of the 150 cars selected for the Best of Best Show Saturday, August 19. He was told that evening that his Monaro was selected to be in the two-mile parade before the race.

"The parade was awesome," said Mr. Engle. "I have been a fan of Nextel racing for more than 15 years, but to be selected to be in the parade was a dream come true."

The 350 Monaro with a LS1 Corvette engine with 4,000 miles was built in Australia by the
