Michigan, where many Island visitors live, Mr. Hokans said, "We don't want to go the way of the fur trade because we ran out of visitors because of other external forces."

Mr. Hart said the Island is feeling the effects of "bad decisions in the boardrooms of Detroit."

Mr. Hokans suggested the Island consider value packaging, with one ticket price for specific destinations, so visitors would not think they were opening their wallets all the time.

"For \$59 you can ride the boat, jump on a carriage tour, visit the porch of Grand Hotel, visit the fort, and go to a butterfly gar-

den," he said. "No one knows that. We've got to join the Disney Worlds and Cedar Points in the marketing, but at the same time, preserve and protect the real thing that they aren't and we are."

Filming for the "Your Town" series was scheduled to begin Tuesday, September 12.
