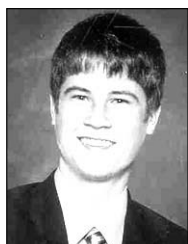
He is the son of Brian and Trudy Olsen of St. Ignace.

The St. Ignace girls and boys track and field team finished fourth during the 13-team Inland Lakes Invitational Monday, April 23.

The host Inland Lakes Bulldogs won both the girls and boys titles, while Onaway finished second in the both divisions. Mancelona took third in the girls and Bellaire placed third in the boys.

Wheeler reached a height of 4'8" and Austin St. Louis at 5'4" to lead the way for the Saints track teams.
