

John R. Scherer, a 1999 Cedarville High School graduate, was inducted into the Zeta chapter of the Alpha Omega Alpha National Honor Medical Society in February at the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry in Rochester, New York.

Alpha Omega Alpha, the only national honor medical society in the world, promotes scholarship and research in medical schools. Mr. Scherer is to be graduated with distinction in research on colon cancer screening from University of Rochester May 18. While he was at the university, he conducted research on multiple sclerosis, inflammatory bowel disease, and colon cancer. He presented his research at several national conferences including the American Academy of Neurology, the American College of Gastroenterology, and the American Academy of Physicians in the cities of Miami, Florida, San Diego, California, and Las Vegas, Nevada. He received honors in his third-year clerkships in medicine, pediatrics, obstetrics, gynecology, neurology, and surgery. He has been a volunteer tutor to elementary school children, and has been a volunteer at the student-run Wellness Center in Rochester.

In June, he will begin an internal medicine residency at McGaw Medical Center of Northwestern Hospital in Chicago. He plans to specialize in gastroenterology. He is the son of Dr. John and Mary Scherer of Cedarville and the grandson of Charlotte and Ed Hammersmith of Norwalk, Ohio, the late Isabel P. Scherer, and the late Dr. Ross W. Dobbs. During undergraduate studies at Central Michigan University, Mr. Scherer was president of the pre-medical society, joined the Sigma Tau Gamma National fraternity, and wrote his honors thesis on Huntington's disease. He was graduated with honors and a bachelor's degree Magna Cum Laude in the Honors Program in 2003, with a dual major in biology and neurosciences. Mr. Scherer was graduated from high school as the valedictorian, was a member of the National Honor Society, tutored students, and received an academic all-state award.

Bishop Kelsey To Receive Honors

The Right Reverend James Kelsey, bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Northern Michigan, will receive an honorary doctorate degree during commencement ceremonies at the Episcopal Divinity School in Cambridge, Massachusetts, Thursday, May 17. Bishop Kelsey is "an advocate for collaborative ministry, a non-hierarchical form of leadership, which includes locally ordained priests and a team of personas who share ministry support responsibilities," said The Right Reverend Steven Charleston, the divinity school's president. The school, he said, "recognizes Bishop James Kelsey and the Diocese of Northern Michigan for their prophetic leadership in supporting the baptismal ministry of all Episcopalians and for their work in helping to transform congregations from being communities gathered around a minister to ministering communities."
