Sarah Mastaw – will major in criminal justice at LSSU in Sault Ste. Marie. She received a Hughes Sisters Scholarship.

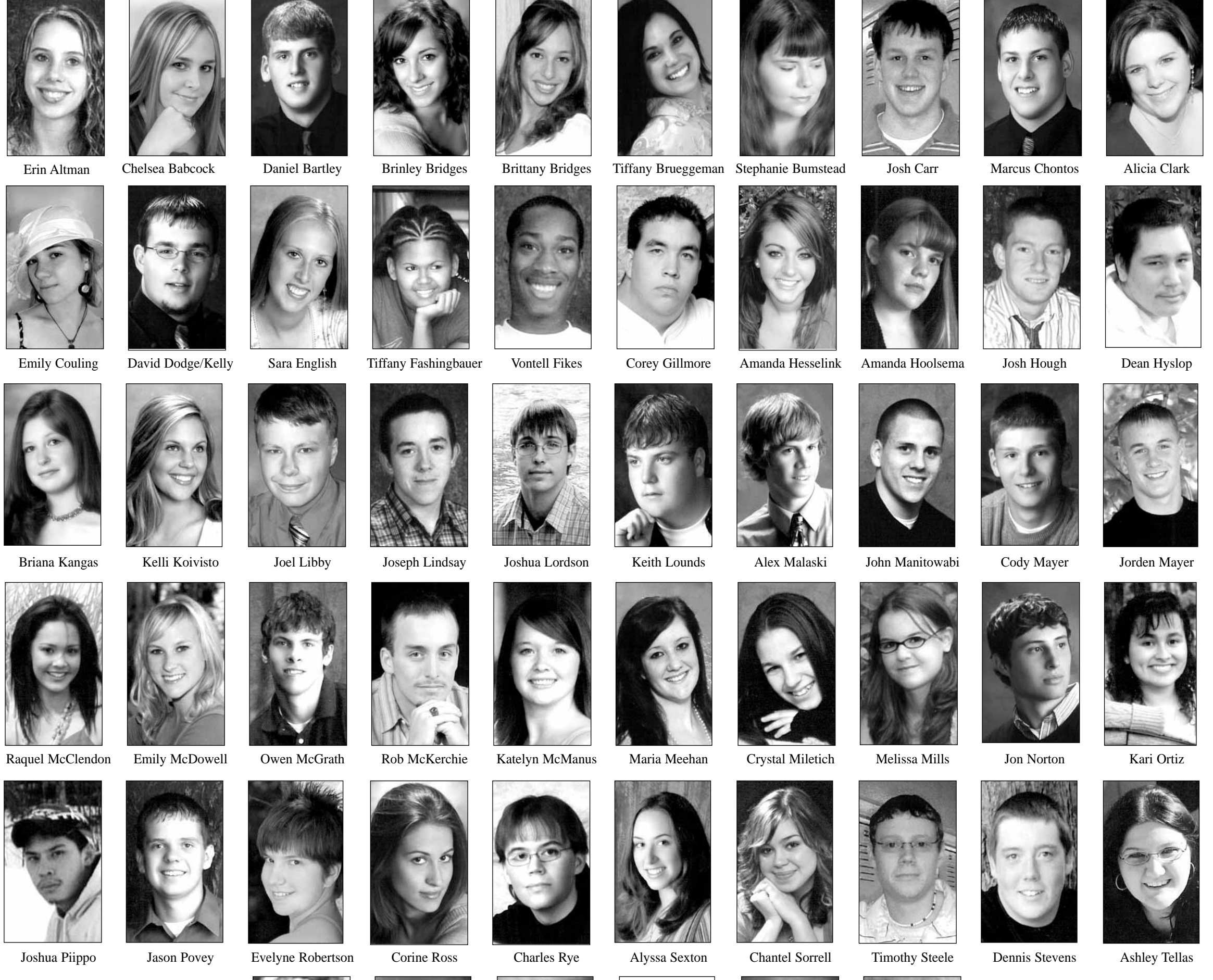
