## Brimley Girls Win First Regional Crown in School History

The Cedarville Trojans boys defended their title and the Brimley Bays girls won their first crown during the Division 3 regional track and field championships at Pickford Friday, May 16.

The first four places in the individual events and relays qualified for the Upper Peninsula Finals meet Saturday, May 31, at Kingsford, which will begin at 10 a.m.

Before winning consecutive championships, the Trojans went

25 years without a title. Cedarville and Brimley each took nine first places en route to their titles.

In the boys division, Cedarville earned a total of 81.5 points, followed by Pickford with 41.5, Brimley 23, Engadine 20, DeTour 18, and Mackinac Island 1.

In the girls division, Brimley scored a total of 65.3 points, followed by Pickford with 57, Engadine 27.33, Cedarville 33, Mackinac Island 8, DeTour 4.3.

In the relays, the Bays finished first in the 800 (1:40.77), second in the 1600, third in the 3200, and fourth in the 400.

**Engadine:** John Troyer, first in shot put (48'7.5"), first in discus (137'8.5"); Phillip Hood, second in 100 and 400, third in 200 and long jump.

**DeTour:** Teryn Miller, first in high jump (5'8.2), second in 1600 and 3200; Mathias Kristensen, second in high jump.

The Raiders 400 and 800 relay teams took third.

**Mackinac Island:** Woody Beardsley, fourth in discus.
