St. Ignace Girls Defend Division 2 Track Crown

The St. Ignace Saints girls defended their title, and the boys finished third during the Division 2 track and field championships at Manistique Friday, May 16.

Saints girls Coach Diane Huskey and her squad qualified 15 girls in the individual or relay events for the Upper Peninsula Finals in Kingsford Saturday, May 31.

"I have been pleased with our effort all season, especially at the regionals," said Coach Huskey. "Our balanced effort has been the key to our success this year."

St. Ignace won with a total team points of 50.5, followed by Munising with 38.5, Manistique 31, Stephenson 24, Rudyard 23, and Newberry 20.

In the boys division, Stephenson won with a total team points of 56, followed by Manistique with 37, St. Ignace 34.5, Munising 28, Newberry 19.5, and Rudyard 12.
