

St. Ignace Falls to Newberry in Championship Game of Saints Tournament

The St. Ignace Saints baseball team posted a dramatic 2-1 come-from-behind win over the Harbor Springs Rams in the semifinals, but fell to the Newberry Indians 12-3 in the championship game of the St. Ignace Tournament Saturday, May 17.

In the championship game, Newberry scored one run in the first inning, five in the third, four in the fourth, and two in the fifth.

St. Ignace's only offensive productive inning was in the fifth, where the team scored three runs.

The Saints earned a trip to the title game with a bases-loaded, two-out single by Rob Robinson in the sixth inning against Harbor Springs, scoring two runs, earlier that day.

St. Ignace trailed 1-0 after Harbor Springs scored its only run in the first inning.

In the bottom of the sixth, James Peterson singled with one out, followed by an Andy Tamlyn single, and Austin St. Louis drew a walk to load the bases for the Saints.

With two outs, Robinson singled to score Peterson and Tamlyn for the game-winning RBIs.

Saints pitcher Gerrit Mortensen pitched a complete game, allowing four hits and one run to earn the win.
